The manuscripts consist almost entirely of notebooks, account books, diaries, and log books kept by Captain William Owen, RN (d. 1778). The earlier notebooks are his school exercise books in arithmetic, geometry, trigonometry, astronomy and navigation, 1746-9. Among these are account books in his autograph which purport to record the dealings of 'me William Owen of Shrewsbury, merchant, 1746', but which are probably no more than exercises in book-keeping. There is another manuscript which connects him with Shrewsbury. It contains a list of persons who were invited to dine with the mayor of Shrewsbury in 1775. The mayor of Shrewsbury for that year was Captain William Owen.

The more important manuscripts include a fine series of well-written and occasionally-illustrated log books of a number of ships of the Royal Navy and other vessels in which Captain Owen served between 1750 and 1775; signal books; meteorological observations made by him on the island of Campobello in Passamaquoddy Bay off the coast of New Brunswick, to which he led a party of

settlers*; and an account of an action against the French in the East Indies, April 29, 1758. Records of the services of another sailor, Edward Owen Jones, 1815-25, the son of Dr Edward Jones mentioned below, are among these naval papers.

There are also numerous personal documents, patents and warrants of appointments, etc., of the said William Owen, of two of his nephews, Sir Arthur Davies Owen and William Owen, KC, of the latter's great-great-nephew, Arthur Charles Humphreys-Owen, and of Edward Jones or Johnes, MD, the grandfather of A. C. Humphreys-Owen; and material for pedigrees of several families, especially those of Owen and Devereux.

The total number of letters exceeds 6,700. The list of correspondents is much too long to be given in this brief survey, but the greater part of the letters may be roughly grouped as letters to or from William Owen, RN; his brother, Edward Owen, MA, rector of Warrington; the three brothers-Sir Arthur Davies Owen, David Owen, MA, of Campobello, and William Owen, KC; Mrs. Anne Warburton Owen, wife of the last-named, and members of the family of Rev Thomas Coupland of Preston, her first husband; Arthur Charles Humphreys-Owen, who succeeded to the Glansevern estate under a settlement made by Mrs Anne Warburton Owen; and Edward Jones or Johnes, MD.

There is also a large number of miscellaneous manuscript and printed papers which relate to a variety of local activities. Among the subjects which are represented are:- the affairs of the island of Campobello, 1770-1830; the Berriew Association for the Prosecution of Felons, 1804; Berriew Parish Church, 1686-1845; Berriew School, 1898; chapel and church disputes; the Llanidloes Association for the Prosecution of Felons, 1800; Llanidloes Intermediate Schools, 1903; Llanllugan enclosure, 1846-9; the Montgomeryshire Association for the Preservation of the Constitution, 1793; the Montgomeryshire Association for the Preservation of Game, 1812; Montgomeryshire and Radnorshire elections, parliamentary (county and borough) 1774-1894, and county council, 1888-1904; Montgomeryshire canals, turnpike roads, bridges, and railways, 1799-1874; Montgomeryshire land tax assessments, 1693; Montgomeryshire county rate assessments, 1827; Montgomeryshire poor relief; the Montgomeryshire Gaol; Montgomeryshire, Brecknock, Oswestry, and other local horse races, 1822-30; the Montgomeryshire Yeomanry Cavalry and Militia, 1803-16; Montgomery borough papers, eighteenth century; minutes of the Committee of the Cymmrodorion Society in Powys, 1824; minutes of the first county court of William Pugh, sheriff of Montgomeryshire, 1767; minutes of a General Meeting of the Welshpool Coffee and Billiard Room, 1810; Newtown Church, 1843; Newtown Public Rooms, 1833; ordinances of the town of Pool, undated; the Powys Eisteddfod, 1824; statistics of friendly societies in Montgomeryshire, 1875; the Welshpool Old Bank, 1807-19; and Welshpool Post Office regulations, 1812.

The deeds and documents number over 2,600 and range from the thirteenth century to the nineteenth. Most of them relate to properties in Montgomeryshire, particularly in the parishes of Berriew, Kerry, Llangurig, Llanwnnog, Llanerchrochwell and Broniarth and Llandinam, but there are deeds of properties in Radnorshire, Pembrokeshire, Cheshire, Lancashire, Warwickshire, Middlesex and the island of Campobello.

There are also several schedules, maps and plans and some legal documents which include a manuscript volume of the rules of practice in the Court of Great Sessions for the counties of Denbigh and Montgomery.
