Manorial records include a rental (1508) and court rolls (1507, 1538, 1548) of the manor of Crasswell, co. Hereford.

(a) 1695, a record of votes cast for Sir Rowland Gwynne and Edward Jones.

(b) 1702, a record of votes cast for Sir Rowland Gwynne and John Jeffreys.

Sir Rowland Gwynne was unsuccessful in both contests.

An important group of assessments of taxes (window, land, horse, and house) in the hundreds of Merthyr and Devynock, co. Brecon, between 1743 and 1787.

The name of John Wynne ap John Gryffyth Vychan is written at the foot of the last page of this section.

The remainder of the manuscript (folios 52-147) is in several hands of the end of the seventeenth century. At the head of folio 52 is the following note: 'Haec sequens Collectio facta fuit Opera P. V. A. M. . . .' The initials probably stand for the name of Peter Vaughan, MA, who was vicar of Llangernyw from 1682 to 1689. This part of the manuscript contains pedigrees of some Abergele families taken from the books of Sion Tudur and Rhys Cain. Peter Vaughan was a native of Abergele and the pedigree of his family is given on folio 54. The pedigrees are followed by an account of the five residences of Sir Roger Mostyn in 1682; poems in strict metres ('cywyddau' and 'englynion') by Edmwnd Prys, William Llyn, Morys Dwyfech, Syr Dafydd Trefor, Lewis Glyn Cothi, Harry Howel, Sion Tudur, Gruffydd Phylip, Wiliam Phylip, Richard Phylip, Sion Phylip, Risiart Cynwal, Foulke Prys, Sion Prys, Thomas Prys, Sion Cent, Edward ap Raph, Dafydd ap Gwilym, William Cynwal, Sir Roger Offeiriad, Guto'r Glyn, Meredydd ap Rhys, Lewis Mon, Dafydd Ddu o Hiraddug, Gruffydd ab Ieuan ap Llywelyn Fychan, Morgan ap Huw Lewis, Edward Morris, Lewis Thomas, and Robert Dyfi;
