'Runs' of The Christian Unitarian (1862-6), The Unitarian Almanac (1847-85), The Essex Hall Year Book (1890-5), and the Proceedings of the General Baptist Assembly (1788-1868) are a notable portion of the collection. Many of the books have been annotated by their late owner in his own characteristic style, and authors' autographs are numerous.
