Some of his papers were bequeathed to the Library in 1974 by the late Miss A. G. Jones, J.P., M.A., the present testator's sister. The papers comprise the following groups.

The papers of Rev William Griffiths himself, including details of marches undertaken during his service with the Royal Carmarthen Fusiliers, 1807-12; volume 2 of his journal, 1815-16; his 'text book', 1817-61 ; accounts relating to chapel building, etc., in Gower, 1839-54, to 'the Welsh Methodists Home Missionary Society' and the Trevecca College Fund Collection, 1839-43; and to visits to England and north Wales, 1841-58; sermon notes, 1817-61 ; a group of catechisms prepared for Sunday schools in Gower, 1831-57; and press cuttings from *The Patriot*.

The correspondence of Rev William Griffiths, including letters from [Lady] Barham 1817-23, [Lord] Barham, afterwards [Earl of] Gainsborough, 1825-61, his future wife A. G. Jones, 1825-6, [the Rev] David Charles, Carmarthen, 1822-3, [the Rev] David Howell, 1840-61, [the Rev] Ed[ward] Morgan, Syston, 1841-2, and Robert Smith, Margam Tin Works, 1835-46; letters relating to the withdrawal of Lord Barham's financial support to William Griffiths's ministry, 1836-8; and letters from him to his son, 1841-61.

Papers of William Griffiths, chemist, Aberaeron, only child of Rev Williams Griffiths, including his apprenticeship indenture, 1844; journals, 1847-58; diaries, 1868-78; correspondence, including letters relating to the purchase of the business of chemist and druggist at Aberaeron, 1849-51, and to the education of his son William Gower Griffiths at Holt Academy, Wrexham, 1874-8; and accounts.

Copies of family wills, etc., 1872-1931.

Papers of Thomas Zaccheus Jones (1853-92), including 'Crynodeb o Bregethau y Gymanfa yn Castellnewydd-Emlyn', 1867 ; poetry ; testimonials ; letters from him to his future wife from Judson University, Judsonia, Arkansas, U.S.A., 1879, and after their marriage from Kilkenny, Cardiff, etc., 1887-92; six notebooks, 1888-9, on Roman Law, Jurisprudence, etc.; and two notebooks, 1881-3, of Ellis J. Griffith, Down[ing] College, Cambridge, on Roman Law and Constitutional History of England.

Papers of Mrs. T. Z. Jones (? 1860-1932), eldest daughter of William Griffiths of Aberaeron, including letters from her parents, and from her cousin John [M. Howell] when she was a pupil teacher at Ebley Court, near Stroud, 1877-8; an account book of a school kept by her at Aberaeron, 1879-85; and papers relating to her work as matron of Aberystwyth Theological College, as a Justice of the Peace for the county of Cardigan, as a governor of Aberaeron County School, and as a speaker on behalf of the Coalition Liberals.

Glamorgan, tinplate maker, brother-in-law of T. Z. Jones.

The work begins without a heading of f. iv, and at the end, on f. 24v, is written in uncials 'Incipit edictio secunda Donati grammatici urbis Romae', apparently referring to the third book of the 'Ars maior'. The text of f. 1r, erased and much faded, is an unidentified grammatical treatise. Glosses are frequent in the text and margin, some of them variant textual readings. At the end of f. 6v before the lacuna, the text is continued for seven lines, ending in mid-sentence, by a hand probably not later than the eleventh century. Across the top of ff. 11v and 12r is written the inscription, 'Sadonis est iste liber, sua mater dedit illi. Magnus onor illa sit qui dedit hunc librum'. The manuscript measures 25.3 by 19.9 cms., and contains 24 leaves, consisting of gatherings of 10, 10 and 8, without catchwords. The last leaf of the last gathering is missing. Three leaves are lost between ff. 6 and 7, and probably one or more gatherings are wanting at the beginning and the end. There are 17 lines to the page, and the leaves are edged in red. The script is Carolingian, with titles of sections written in rustic capitals. Initial letters of chapters are filled in red, and at the beginning of the text of f. iv there is a 4-line initial in red, with ornamentation in black in the uncoloured vertical stem. The volume is bound in eighteenth century mottled sheepskin. The manuscript, once in the possession of Guglielmo Libri (1803-69), was sold as lot 320 in the sale of his manuscripts at Sotheby's in 1859. It was bought by Sir Thomas Phillipps (1792-1872), and became MS. 16308 in his collection.

of the length of the page. There are 7 - line initial letters to the Prologue and Books 1, 3 and 8. The volume is bound in late eighteenth or early nineteenth century Russian, with gold tooling on the spine and around the edges of the covers. On the inside cover, pasted over the marks of a removed book plate, is that of Alexander Murray of Broughton, Wigtown in Scotland, a Member of Parliament whose death is recorded in 1750.
