General Election campaigns seem to have become increasingly reliant on the press and television as a means of conveying general party messages but it is often the individual candidates active in deciding which candidates in their particular constituency they wish to see elected and vote accordingly. It is not surprising then that a mass of election literature is still produced by individual candidates. Certainly in Wales glossy election addresses and highly localised (and sometimes misleading) leaflets still play a crucial role in the campaigns in individual constituencies. Such literature is of interest to historians and social scientists as sources of information about candidates, their policies and important local issues.

Peter Hain papers

The Welsh Political Archive was delighted to receive recently one of the very large archive of the papers of the Right Honourable Peter Hain, the Labour MP for Neath. Born in Kenya, Mr Hain was educated at Pretoria Boys' High School, until his anti-apartheid parents were forced to leave the country. He later obtained degrees at Queen Mary College, London and Sussex University. Originally a 'young Liberal', he joined the Labour Party in 1977 and served as research officer of the Union of Communication Workers from 1976 until 1991. He stood as the Labour candidate for Putney in 1983 and 1987, eventually entering the Commons as MP for Neath in 1991 in succession to Donald Coleman. He was a leader of the 1997 Welsh referendum campaign as a Welsh Office Minister and then as a number of ministerial offices at Westminster before being appointed Secretary of State for Wales in 2002, Leader of the House of Commons in 2003, Secretary of State for Northern Ireland in 2005 and Secretary of State for Work and Pensions in 2007. Throughout this six year period he maintained a busy portfolio.

Lord Goronwy Roberts Paper

The Welsh Political Archive was especially delighted to receive from Lady Marion Goronwy-Roberts during February 2003 a large group of the political and personal papers of her husband Goronwy O. Roberts, Lord Goronwy-Roberts (1913-81), Labour MP for Caernarfonshire from 1945 until 1974.

A native of Bethesda, Goronwy Roberts enjoyed a brilliant academic career at the University College of North Wales, Bangor, where he was one of the founder members of the

patriotic Goronwy movement. He captained the winning team in the 1938 Welshman shinty competition and was a member of the voluntary solar administration.

Goronwy Roberts of the Parliament for Wales, was indeed personally involved in the establishment of the National Assembly for Wales in 1999.

Following his defeat in the 1974 general election, Goronwy Roberts was serving as Minister of State for Education and Science.

He was also Deputy Chairman of the Colonial Office and Vice-Chairman of the Commonwealth Office and Trade.

The sorting and cataloguing of the collection is now complete. They have been catalogued in Clas C (Corporate) and Clas P (Personal) material. They comprise a significant collection of political papers.

The collection is now available for consultation at the Library and will be of great significance for political history.

papers are those accumulated by Lloyd George's brother, William, the Criccieth solicitor whose support was vital in the development of Lloyd George's political career.

The papers comprise several thousand letters, diaries and family papers. Lloyd George wrote to his brother regularly and about four thousand of these letters have survived. Though mostly written in haste, they often contain frank and sometimes cutting remarks about colleagues and political opponents, as well as family news.

Twelve early Lloyd George diaries, dating from the period 1878-88, have also survived. They provide an invaluable insight into the psychological development of the young solicitor and aspiring politician. There are

references to his courtship of his future wife and on political events such as the famous visit of Michael Davitt, the Irish radical, to Blaenau Ffestiniog in 1886.

Other diaries among these papers include those of William George and of Lloyd George's uncle and mentor Richard Lloyd ('Uncle Lloyd'). William George's diaries pose a problem in that they are written in late nineteenth century shorthand and require deciphering. The Library would be glad to hear from anyone who has experience in reading such shorthand.

Extracts from the papers are printed on page 3 but the papers themselves will not be available to readers for some time yet while they are being catalogued.

The Welsh Political Archive was set up in 1983 to co-ordinate the collection of documentary evidence of all kinds about politics in Wales. It collects the records and papers of political parties, politicians, quasi-political organisations, campaigns and pressure groups; leaflets, pamphlets and other printed ephemera; posters and photographs; websites and tapes of radio and television programmes. Its work is not restricted to a specific department within the Library.

On its 40th Anniversary we're proud to look back on all that the Welsh Political Archive has achieved during 2022-2023 and look forward to all that is to come over the next 40 years.

- archifau cenedlaethol pleidiau gwleidyddol ond nid ydym bellach yn casglu papurau rhanbarthau na changhennau pleidiau gwleidyddol
- archifau grwpiau pwysedd cenedlaethol a grwpiau sy'n ymgyrchu ar faterion cenedlaethol
- effemera etholiad o bob etholaeth yng Nghymru ar gyfer etholiadau cenedlaethol a referenda gan gynnwys etholiadau Comisiynwyr yr Heddlu a Throsedd. Nid ydym yn casglu deunydd sy'n ymwneud ag etholiadau i awdurdodau lleol.

In accordance with The National Library of Wales' Collection Development Policy, The Welsh Political Archive collects the personal papers of politicians who have played an important role in the life of the nation and individuals with a high profile for campaigning on national or international issues.

We collect:

- the papers of Members of the UK Parliament, Members of the Senedd, Members of the European Parliament and Lords if they have for example held positions such as Secretary of State, party leader, minister, senior committee chair; we do not usually collect the papers of other elected members or constituency papers
- the national archives of political parties but we no longer collect the regional or branch papers of political parties
- archives of national pressure groups and groups which campaign on national issues
- election ephemera from all constituencies in Wales for national elections and referenda including elections for Police and Crime Commissioners. We do not collect material related to elections to local authorities.



David Lloyd George notebook

A notebook used by David Lloyd
George to record his thoughts
and notes for speeches during
the December 1910 General
Election campaign was
purchased at auction in
September 2022. The refusal of
the House of Lords to endorse
Lloyd George's 1909 budget
which included tax reforms to
fund social security payments led
to a General Election to solve the
constitutional standoff in January
1910. A further election was held
in December of that year which
gave the Liberals a mandate to

restrict the power of the House
of Lords through the Parliament
Act 1911. The notebook, which
has a beautifully embroidered
cover and contains around 80
pages of notes on subjects such
as tax, Lords reform and
education, was initially given
to Arthur C. Murray, 3rd
Viscount Elibank (1879-1962)
and was later gifted to
Hermione Hobhouse. The
purchase was part funded by
a grant from the Friends of the
National Libraries.

Dear David,

1. As a former minister of agriculture for Wales (among my other responsibilities as Secretary of State for 6 years), I am deeply concerned about the cumulative effect on UK agriculture and particularly in the devolved areas where animal production plays such a significant role.
2. A detailed impact assessment of FTA is required on sections and areas of the UK economy. I take a grim view of the prospects of livestock producers and hill farmers, in particular over the next 10 years.
3. The Australian imports of beef have hitherto been modest as the Asian markets have been more attractive, however "the worsening of diplomatic relations with China is already having an impact on Australian exports - over the last year there has been a 38% fall in beef exports to China" (page 95 of the NFU England & Wales Evidence.)
4. Animal welfare standards between Australia and the UK diverge widely (Page 99 ditto). This is much wider than differing uses of antibiotics. Branding, mulesing of sheep and transport standards are different (page 100). *"There is no commitment in the FTA for equivalence, only a commitment to endeavour....."* (Page 99). This is a serious mistake by our negotiators. An important trick has been missed.
5. Meat and Livestock Australia believe that the FTA will significantly enhance Australian access to the UK Red Meat Market. (Page 89 ditto). There was a comment in an earlier document before this from an Australian minister that the meat market could increase tenfold.
6. There is critical evidence of the working of the Tariff Rate Quota (Page 90 ditto), and particularly a lack of clarity how the quota volumes have



Darlith Flynyddol 2022

Traddodwyd darlith flynyddol 2022, a roddwyd gan y darlleddwr Huw Edwards ar 4 Tachwedd yn y Drwm yn Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru gyda gwe-ddarlleddiad yr un pryd. Dyma'r tro cyntaf ers 2019 i'r ddarllith gael ei chynnal yn y Llyfrgell; cynhaliwyd trafodaeth banel ar-lein yn 2020 ac yn 2021 traddododd yr Athro Paul O'Leary ei ddarllith ar Lloyd George yn y Senedd yng Nghaerdydd.

Mae Huw Edwards yn wyneb a llais cyfarwydd ers yr 1980au ar y BBC, a thestun y ddarllith oedd ei waith fel gohebydd a lle Cymru yn newyddion a gwleidyddiaeth Prydain. Edrychodd Huw yn ôl ar yr 1980au, gan nodi'n benodol sut roedd y BBC wedi adrodd ar lansio S4C yn 1982 a'r sylw a roddwyd i faterion Cymreig yn Senedd y DU, gan gymharu hynny â'r cyfnod ers datganoli. Soniodd am ffigurau amlwg yng ngwleidyddiaeth Cymru gan gynnwys Jim Griffiths, Megan Lloyd George a Syr Wyn Roberts, y ddadl

Gymraeg gyntaf yn Senedd y DU, datblygiadau megis sefydlu'r Uwch Bwylgor Cymreig, y Pwyllgor Materion Cymreig, penodi Ysgrifennydd Gwladol i Gymru a sefydlu Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru.

Fel rhan o ddigwyddiadau'r dydd cynhaliwyd arddangosfa dros dro yn dangos eitemau o archifau 3 newyddiadurwr amlwg o Gymru: Wynford Vaughan Thomas, Patrick Hannan a Gareth Vaughan Jones yn Ystafell Summers. Fel Huw Edwards, roedd Wynford Vaughan Thomas wedi cyflwyno rhagleni'r BBC ar ddigwyddiadau mawr ym Mhrydain gan gynnwys angladdau brenhinol, Coronï'r Frenhines Elizabeth II a Gŵyl y Cofio yn Neuadd Albert.

The 2022 Annual Lecture

The 2022 annual lecture, given by broadcaster Huw Edwards, was delivered on 4 November in the Drwm at the National Library of Wales with a simultaneous webcast. This is the first time since 2019 that the lecture was held in the Library; a panel discussion was held online in 2020 and in 2021 Professor Paul O'Leary delivered his lecture on Lloyd George in the Senedd in Cardiff.

Huw Edwards is a familiar face and voice since the 1980s on the BBC, and the subject of the lecture was his work as a reporter and Wales' place in British news and politics. Huw looked back at the 1980s, noting in particular how the BBC had reported on the launch of S4C in 1982 and the coverage of Welsh affairs in the UK Parliament, comparing it to the period since devolution. He mentioned some prominent figures in Welsh politics including Jim Griffiths, Megan Lloyd George and Sir Wyn Roberts, the first Welsh debate in the UK Parliament, developments such as the

establishment of the Welsh Grand Committee, the Welsh Affairs Committee, the appointment of a Secretary of State for Wales and the establishment of the National Assembly for Wales.

As part of the day's events a pop up exhibition, showing items from the archives of 3 prominent Welsh journalists: Wynford Vaughan Thomas, Patrick Hannan and Gareth Vaughan Jones was held in the Summers Room. Like Huw Edwards, Wynford Vaughan Thomas had presented BBC programmes on major British events including royal funerals, the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II and the Festival of Remembrance at the Albert Hall.

Lord Morris was MP for Aberavon for over 41 years and had previously been legal officer and Deputy General Secretary of the Farmers' Union of Wales. His substantial archive, covering many highlights of his career including his time as Secretary of State for Wales and Attorney General, is held at the Library and he delivered our annual lecture in 2013.

Ann Clwyd

Publications

***Manifesto 53*, detailing new acquisitions, cataloguing work, promotional and outreach activities and with an article by Dr Sam Blaxland on the grassroots of the Conservative Party in Wales, was published in October 2023.**

Rob Phillips wrote an article for the winter 2022 edition of *Cara* magazine, detailing the *Gwir Gofnod o Gyfnod/Setting the Record Straight* project, led by Women's Archive Wales to collect oral histories and paper archives from women who have served as members of the National Assembly for Wales and the Welsh Parliament.

***The Campaigns of Margaret Lloyd George* by Richard O'Brien was published by Y Lolfa in late 2022. 



Gweithio ar Bapurau Ann Clwyd

Roedd Ann Clwyd yn sicr yn fenyw ddylanwadol yn hanes y Blaid Lafur a Gwleidyddiaeth Cymru yn ehangach ac yn un a gafodd yrfa amrywiol ac arwyddocaol. Gwasanaethodd fel ASE o 1979 ac yna fel AS Cwm Cynon o 1984 tan 2019; hi oedd y fenyw gyntaf i glynrychioli'r etholaeth honno. Yn ei chyfnod ar y meinciau cefn ac o fewn y cabinet bu'n hyrwyddo ystod o achosion, o gefnogi glowyr Glofa'r Twr, i achos y Cwrdiaid ac ymgyrchu dros Hawliau Dynol yma a thrarmor.

Mae hyn yn amlwg o'r casgliad helaeth a drosglwyddodd i'r Llyfrgell Genedlaethol. Rwyf wedi bod yn gweithio trwy ei harchif o dros 100 o focsys ac yn mynd trwy bob un i weld pa ddeunydd sydd yno ac i gael trosolwg o'i gyrrfa ynghyd â'r achosion a hyrwyddodd a'r rolau a gyflawnodd. Mae'r archif yn rhoi darlun cyflawn o'i gyrrfa a gwybodaeth hanesyddol werthfawr o ddiwedd yr 20fed ganrif i'r 21ain ganrif. Yn arbennig, maent yn cynnig cipolwg ar feysydd fel y Blaid Lafur yng Nghymru a'r DU ehangach a'i pherthynas ag unigolion allweddol. Ar yr un pryd mae'n dangos safbwytiau ei hetholwyr a phobl eraill ledled y DU trwy lythyrau a gohebiaeth gyffredinol ac yn rhoi golwg onest ar agweddu tuag at ei gwaith, boed yn gadarnhaol neu'n negyddol. Heb os nac oni bai, mae wedi bod yn ddiddorol mynd trwy'r deunydd hwn fel rhywun a gafodd ei geni yn hanner olaf y '90au. Mae'n rhoi'r cyd-destun a mewnwelediad hanesyddol gwerthfawr i faterion sy'n dal i effeithio arnom yn gynnar yn yr 21ain ganrif.

Yn hollbwysig, mae yna hefyd lawer o ddeunyddiau sy'n gysylltiedig â'i hymrwymiad i ddelio â hawliau dynol mewn lleoedd fel Twrci, Timor-Leste (Dwyrain Timor), Rwanda, y Balcanau, Sierra Leone, a Cambodia. Mae'r ffocws a'r ymrwymiad hwn i gefnogi a gofalu am hawliau dynol pobl gartref a thrarmor yn amlwg o'r amrywiaeth o ffeiliau a deunyddiau sy'n ymwneud ag ymwelliadau, trafodaethau, a gwaith gyda sefydliadau y bu'n eu cynorthwyo neu eu cefnogi. Roedd yn rhan fawr o'i gyrrfa ac mae'n cael llawer o sylw yn yr archif.

Working on Ann Clwyd's Papers

Ann Clwyd was certainly an influential woman in the history of the Labour Party and Welsh Politics more widely and she had a varied and significant career. She served as an MEP from 1979 and then as MP for the Cynon Valley from 1984 until 2019; she was the first woman to represent that constituency. In her time as a backbencher and within the cabinet she championed a range of causes, from supporting the Tower Colliery miners, to the Kurdish cause and campaigning for Human Rights here and abroad.

This is evident from the extensive collection she transferred to the National Library. I have been working through her archive of more than 100 boxes and going through each one to determine what material is present and to get an overview of her career along with the causes she championed and the roles she undertook. The archives give a rounded picture of her career and valuable historical information of the late 20th Century into the 21st century. Notably, it gives insight into areas such as the Labour Party in both Wales and the wider UK and her relationship with key individuals. At the same time it provides perspectives from her constituents and other people throughout the UK through general letters and correspondence, including an honest insight into attitudes towards her work, whether positive or negative. Without a doubt, it has been interesting to go through this material as someone born in the latter half of the '90s. It provides the context and valuable historical insight into issues which still affect us in the early 21st century.

Crucially, there are also many materials related to her commitment to dealing with human rights in places such as Turkey, Timor-Leste (East Timor), Rwanda, the Balkans, Sierra Leone and Cambodia. This focus and commitment to supporting and caring for people's human rights home and abroad is evident from the range of files and materials covering visits, discussions and work with organisations she helped or supported. It was a major part of her career and is well represented in the archive.

Mae yna hefyd lawer o ddeunyddiau yn ymwneud ag Irac a'r Cwrdiaid. Maen nhw'n cwmpasu dros 40 mlynedd o'i gwaith, cyn, yn ystod ac ar ôl Rhyfel Irac. Mae yna ddeunyddiau amrywiol o'r Adran dros Ddatblygu Rhwngwladol (DFID), adroddiadau INDICT, gohebiaeth gan bobl o bob cefndir ac adroddiadau am am yr ymwelliadau rheolaidd a wnaeth ar ran y sefydliadau hyn a gohebiaeth at y Prif Weinidog, Tony Blair, pan oedd yn Gennad Arbennig i Irac. Maen nhw'n cynnwys gwybodaeth sylwedol a gwerthfawr ond gallan nhw hefyd fod yn heriol oherwydd natur y cynnwys, yn ogystal â bod angen eu gwirio'n ofalus oherwydd y wybodaeth bersonol sensitif sydd yn y ffeiliau hyn. Mae cydwysedd anodd yma rhwng parchu preifatrwydd a chyfrinachedd y bobl y sonnir amdanyn nhw yn y ffeiliau hyn a darparu mynediad i giatatâu ymchwil. Fodd bynnag, pan fyddwn yn canfod data personol sensitif y penderfyniad arferol yw cyfyngu mynediad i'r ffeiliau yn unol â deddfwriaeth Diogelu Data a Rhyddid Gwybodaeth. Mae hon wedi bod yn broses ryfeddol a heriol.

Ar y cyfan, mae mynd trwy gasgliad mor gynhwysfawr wedi bod yn broses ddiddorol a dim ond ychydig o'r pynciau a'r safbwytiau sydd yn y papurau yr wyf wedi gallu eu crybwyll. Mae wedi bod yn gyfle gwych i mi ac yn adnodd hynod ddiddorol i'r rhai sy'n ymddiddor yn Ann Clwyd a'r achosion y bu'n eu hyrwyddo.

Sian Smith yw'r archifydd prosiect sy'n gweithio ar Bapurau Ann Clwyd. Mynychodd Ysgol Uwchradd Pontypridd ac mae ganddi radd mewn Hanes a gradd ôl-raddedig mewn Rheoli Archifau a Chofnodion o Brifysgol Aberystwyth. Cyn hyn bu'n gwneud gwaith gwirfoddol gyda Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru ac Archifau Morgannwg ac mae wedi bod yn gweithio yn Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru ers mis Rhagfyr 2022.

There are also extensive materials related to Iraq and the Kurdish people. They cover over 40 years of her involvement, before, during and after the Iraq War. There are various materials from the Department for International Development (DFID), INDICT reports, correspondence from people of all backgrounds and her routine visit reports made for these organisations and to the Prime Minister, Tony Blair, when she was Special Envoy to Iraq. They contain significant and valuable information but can also be challenging due to the nature of the content, as well as requiring careful checking due to the sensitive personal information contained in these files. There is a difficult balance between respecting privacy and the confidentiality of people who are mentioned in these files and providing access to allow research. However, where we identify sensitive personal data the default position is to limit access to the files in line with Data Protection and Freedom of Information legislation. I've found this a fascinating and challenging process.

Overall, it has been an interesting process going through such a comprehensive collection and I've only been able to mention a few of the topics and perspectives the papers contain. It has been a great opportunity for me and a fascinating resource for those interested in Ann Clwyd and the causes she championed.

Pan drosglwyddodd Ann Clwyd ei phapurau i Lyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru, roedd yn awyddus iawn iddyn nhw gael eu defnyddio ar gyfer astudio cyn gynted â phosibl. Roedd y Llyfrgell hefyd yn frwdrydig a daeth o hyd i bartner parod iawn yn adran Gwleidyddiaeth Ryngwladol Prifysgol Aberystwyth.

Gweithiais gyda Dr James Vaughan ar gais am wobr Efrydiaeth PhD Cydweithredol y Cyngor Ymchwil Economaidd a Chymdeithasol (ESRC) i fyfyrwr weithio ar y casgliad, gan ganolbwntio ar y Mudiad Llafur Prydeinig a'r Ymgrych dros Hawliau Democraidd a Hawliau Dynol yn Irac rhwng 1984 a 2010.

Bydd y prosiect yn archwilio cyfraniadau Cymreig i faterion ehangach polisi trarmor Prydain a chysylltiau rhyngwladol, ac yn benodol gyfraniad y Blaid Lafur Gymreig tuag at lunio polisi Irac, a lleoli'r dadansoddiad hwn o fewn traddodiadau rhyngwladoldeb Cymru sy'n dyddio'n ôl i'r Rhyfel Mawr. Bydd yn dadansoddi'r berthynas rhwng yr ymgyrchoedd hynny ac ymddangosiad Llafur Newydd fel plaid lywodraethol, sydd wedi ymrwymo i bwyslais o'r newydd ar ddimensiynau moesegol polisi trarmor gan ddarparu set ddiddorol a phwysig o fewnwelediadau i'r berthynas rhwng actifiaeth hawliau dynol Prydeinig-Iracaidd a llwybr Ilywodraeth Blair tuag at Ryfel Irac 2003 a dymchweliad Saddam Hussein.

Bydd y prosiect hefyd yn tynnu ar grwpiau o actifyddion ac ymgrychwr o fewn cymunedau Cwrdiadaid ac Iracaidd yng Nghymru, gan ddibynnu ar bapurau Ann Clwyd ac archifau eraill yn Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru yn ogystal â mewn cadwfeidd eraill. Agwedd bwysig o'r prosiect yw cyfraniad Ann Clwyd ei hun a'i hawydd i ddarparu ei mewnwelediad unigryw ei hun i'r digwyddiadau hyn a chyd-destun i'r dogfennau sy'n rhan o'r archif.

Bydd tîm goruchwyliau'r prosiect yn fy nghynnwys i, Dr James Vaughan a Dr Gillian McFadyen o Adran Gwleidyddiaeth Ryngwladol Prifysgol Aberystwyth. Bydd fy nghyfraniad i ar ran y Llyfrgell yn cynnwys hwyluso mynediad i'r casgliad, mynchy tri chyfarfod goruchwyliau, rhoi cyngor ar gynllunio ymchwil prosiect, lledaenu ac ymgysylltu â'r cyhoedd, a gweithgareddau cyfnewid gwybodaeth.

Penodwyd Benjamin Woodburn i'r efrydiaeth ym mis Mawrth 2023 a'r gobaith yw y bydd yn dechrau ar ei waith yn yr Hydref. Bydd Siân Smith, yr archifydd prosiect, yn gweithio gyda Benjamin i roi hyfforddiant iddo mewn ymarfer archifol, diogelu data ac egwyddorion rhyddid gwybodaeth a bydd e'n cyfrannu at flog casgliad y Llyfrgell, a *Manifesto: Cylchlythr Blynnyddol Archif Wleidyddol Gymreig* gan ei sefydlu fel arbenigwr cyhoeddus yn y maes.

Mae'r cydweithio hwn yn brosiect cyffrous iawn i'r Archif Wleidyddol Gymreig a bydd yn helpu i gyflawni rhannau allweddol o'n cenhadaeth nid yn unig i gasglu a storio ond hefyd i hyrwyddo mynediad ac astudio a darparu dehongliad ysgolheigaidd o ddeunydd archifol sy'n adlewyrchu bywyd gwleidyddol Cymru.

Partnership with Aberystwyth University

When Ann Clwyd transferred her papers to the National Library of Wales, she was very keen that they be used for study as soon as possible. The Library was also keen and found a very willing partner in the department of International Politics at Aberystwyth University.

I worked with Dr James Vaughan on an application for an Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC) Collaborative PhD Studentship award for a student to work on the collection, concentrating on the British Labour Movement and Campaign for Democratic and Human Rights in Iraq between 1984 and 2010.

The project will explore Welsh contributions to broader issues of British foreign policy and international relations, specifically the contribution of the Welsh Labour Party towards the formulation of Iraq policy, and locate this analysis within traditions of Welsh internationalism dating back to the Great War. It will analyse the relationship between those campaigns and New Labour's emergence as a party of government, committed to a renewed emphasis on the ethical dimensions of foreign policy providing a fascinating and important set of insights into the relationship between British-Iraqi human rights activism and the Blair government's path towards the 2003 Iraq War and the overthrow of Saddam Hussein.

The project will also draw upon activist groups and campaigners within Kurdish and Iraqi communities in Wales, relying on Ann Clwyd papers and other archives at the National Library of Wales as well as in other repositories. An important aspect of the project is the involvement of Ann Clwyd herself and her eagerness to provide her own unique insight into these events and context to the documents which make up the archive.

The project's supervisory team will consist of myself, Dr James Vaughan and Dr Gillian McFadyen from the Department of International Politics at Aberystwyth University. My contribution on behalf of the Library will include facilitating access to the collection, attending three supervisory meetings, advising on project research design, dissemination and public engagement, and knowledge exchange activities.

Benjamin Woodburn was appointed to the studentship in March 2023 and it is hoped that he will begin work in the Autumn. Siân Smith, the project archivist will work with Benjamin to provide him with training in archival practice, data protection and freedom of information principles and he will contribute to the Library's collection blog, and *Manifesto: The Welsh Political Archive Annual Newsletter* establishing him as a public expert in the field.

This collaboration is a very exciting project for the Welsh Political Archive and will help achieve key parts of our mission not just to collect and store but to promote access and study and provide scholarly interpretation of archival material which reflects the political life of Wales.

Mae deugain mlynedd ers sefydlu'r Archif Wleidyddol Gymreig yn achlysur sy'n galw am ddathliad arbennig. Er bod y Llyfrgell, ers ei sefydlu, wedi derbyn rhoddion hael o lawysgrifau a deunydd archifol arall, daeth yn amlwg i aelodau ymroddedig o staff y Llyfrgell ar ddechrau'r 1980au y gallai fod angen dull mwy uniongyrchol o nodi deunydd o ddiddordeb ar adeg o gynnwrf gwleidyddol arbennig, heb sôn am effaith hirdymor methiant y prosiect Datganoli a'r rhwyg o fewn y Blaid Lafur a arweiniodd at greu'r Blaid Ddemocratiaid Gymdeithasol. Roedd rhai adnoddau wedi'u nodi yn dilyn llwyddiant Apêl Pen-blwydd y Llyfrgell yn 75 oed ac yn gynnar yn 1983, ffurfiwyd pwylgor mewnol bychan i archwilio'r ffordd orau o wireddu'r weledigaeth o archif ddeinamig. Cefais y frant o ymuno fel cynrychiolydd Cyngor y Llyfrgell a mynchu'r cyfarfodydd bob yn ail wythnos i ddatblygu gweledigaeth a strategaeth a mecanwaith priodol. Roedd hwn yn brofiad gwfreiddiol oherwydd roedd yn amlwg i bob un ohonom ein bod yn mynd i mewn i diriogaeth ddiarth ond rhywbeth a allai, gydag amser, ddod â manteision gwirioneddol i'r Llyfrgell ac i'r gwaith o astudio gwleidyddiaeth a hanes Cymru.

Ac felly y bu. Mae Gwyn Jenkins, cyn bennaeth Llawysgrifau a chadeirydd y pwylgor cyntaf hwnnw, wedi rhoi disgrifiad rhagorol o esblygiad yr Archif dros ei deng mlynedd ar hugain cyntaf (*Manifesto*, Rhifyn 44, 2013). Ar y cychwyn, fodd bynnag, roedd yn amlwg y dylai'r ffiniau ar gyfer casglu deunydd fod mor eang â phosibl. Yn fuan ar ôl sefydlu'r pwylgor mewnol, galwyd Etholiad Cyffredinol, a hwn oedd y cyfle a'r her wirioneddol gyntaf i'r Archif newydd. Taflwyd y rhwyd yn eang, ac un awgrym nodedig a dderbyniwyd oedd sefydlu rhwydwaith cenedlaethol o wyrffodolwyr i gasglu deunyddiau ymgyrchu ym mhob etholaeth yng Nghymru a chysylltwyd â chwmniau cyfryngau i ofyn am dapiau o gyfweliadau. Daeth yn amlwg yn fuan hefyd fod cofnodion sefydliadau ymgyrchu a charfanau pwysa yn gofnod hanesyddol hanfodol bwysig, a oedd mor aml yn cael eu hanwybyddu.


Mae'r rhestr o archifau a gasglwyd dros y pedwar degawd dilynol yn dystiolaeth huawd o lwyddiant yr Archif. Mae rhifynnau olynol o'r Cylchlythyr, sydd ei hun wedi esblygu o'i rifyn cyntaf syml ym 1984/5 i fod yn gyhoeddriad blynnyddol deniadol iawn, yn dangos ystod, dyfnder ac ansawdd y deunydd sydd wedi'i gasglu a'i gadw, o gofnodion y prif bleidiau gwleidyddol yng Nghymru a'u canghennau etholaethol i archifau personol nifer fawr iawn o ASau Cymru a ffigurau cyhoeddus nodedig, rhywbeth y mae rhywun yn ei amau na fyddai effalai wedi digwydd fel arall.



The Welsh Political Archive at 40: a vision realised

The fortieth anniversary of the Welsh Political Anniversary is a moment for real celebration. While the Library had, since its inception, received generous donations of manuscripts and other archival material, it became clear to dedicated members of staff within the Library in the early 1980s that a more direct approach might be needed to identify material of interest at a time of particular political turbulence not least the lingering impact of the failed Devolution project and the schism within the Labour Party which had led to the creation of the Social Democratic Party. Some resources had been identified following the Library's successful 75th Anniversary Appeal and in early 1983, a small internal committee was formed to explore the best way of achieving the vision of a dynamic archive. I was privileged to join as the representative of the Library's Council and to attend the bi-weekly meetings to develop a vision and appropriate strategy and mechanism. This was an enthralling experience because it was clear to us all that we were entering uncharted territory but something which could, over time, yield real benefits to the Library and to the study of Welsh politics and history.



O'r cychwyn cyntaf, mae staff yr Archif wedi cael cefnogaeth gref gan aelodau brwdfrydig y Pwyllgor Ymgynghorol cynrychioliadol, a sefydlwyd gan Fwrdd Ymddiriedolwyr y Llyfrgell, ac sy'n dod o bob rhan o'r sbectrwm gwleidyddol gan gynnwys gwleidyddion, academyddion a newyddiadurwyr sy'n eistedd ochr yn ochr â staff y Llyfrgell. Cynhalwyd cyfarfod cyntaf y Pwyllgor ym mis Ebrill 1984 a bu'r aelodau'n ffynhonnell amhrisiadwy o gyngor, yn aml yn dod â chasgliadau o ddeunydd i gyfarfodydd yn frwdfrydig, yn cyfeirio staff yr Archif at ddeunydd o ddiddordeb, neu'n anfon sylwadau at etholaethau a phleidiau lleol ar ran y Llyfrgell. Ac yn y Pwyllgor y cynigwyd y syniad o Ddarlith Flynyddol sydd, o 1987 ymlaen, wedi bod yn ffocws allweddol i'r Archif, gan roi cyfre i wleidyddion ac academyddion o fri fyfyrion ar eu gyrfaoedd mewn lleoliad cyhoeddus.

Mae hefyd yn destun pleser mawr fod staff yr Archif dros y blynnyddoedd wedi cyfrannu'n helaeth at ein dealltwriaeth o wleidyddiaeth Cymru. Mae cyhoeddiadau Beti Jones yn cynnwys llawlyfr amhrisiadwy o ystadegau etholiadol Cymru ac mae John Graham Jones wedi cyhoeddi erthyglau dirifedi ar hanes gwleidyddol Cymru. Mae Gwyn Jenkins, wrth gwrs, yn awdurdodedig ar hanes Cymru a bywgraffiadau, a daeth cynorthwywyd ymchwil cyntaf yr Archif, Paul O'Leary, maes o law yn ddeilydd cadair Hanes Cymru Syr John Williams ym Mhrifysgol Aberystwyth ac ef gyflwynodd ddarlith flynyddol yr Archif yn 2021.

Dros yr ychydig flynyddoedd diwethaf mae heriau newydd wedi ymddangos, wrth gwrs, yn enwedig dyfodiad y cyfryngau cymdeithasol a diflaniad graddol y ffurfiâu hŷn o gadw cofnodion, gohebiaeth a ysgrifennwyd â llaw, neu'r llythyr traddodiadol. Ac eto, fel erioed, mae'r Llyfrgell a'r Archif yn ymwybodol o hyn ac yn ceisio ymateb yn briodol.

Ac rwy'n arbennig o fach fod yr Archif, ddeugain mlynedd yn ddiweddarach, yn parhau i ffynnu dan arweiniad Rob Philips a bod rhai ohonom, sy'n dal yn aelodau o'r Pwyllgor Ymgynghorol ar ôl deugain mlynedd, yn gallu edrych yn ôl ar weledigaeth sydd wedi'i gwireddu.

Mae Syr Deian Hopkin yn gyn Lywydd Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru ac yn Is-Ganhellor Prifysgol South Bank Llundain. Mae'n Llywydd Anrhydeddus Cymdeithas y Cymrodonion ac mae ganddo PhD mewn Hanes o Brifysgol Aberystwyth. Mae wedi bod yn ymwneud â'r Archif Wleidyddol Gymreig ers ei sefydlu.

And so it proved. Gwyn Jenkins, the former head of Manuscripts and chair of that first committee, has given an excellent account of the evolution of the Archive over its first thirty years (*Manifesto*, Issue 44, 2013). At the outset, however, it was clear that the boundaries for collecting material should be as broad as possible. Soon after the internal committee was established, a General Election was called, and this presented the first real opportunity and challenge for the nascent Archive. A wide net was cast, and a notable innovation was the establishment of a national network of volunteers to collect campaign materials in every Welsh constituency while media companies were contacted to deposit interview tapes. Early on, moreover, it also became clear that the records of campaigning organisations and pressure groups were a vitally important historical record, so often overlooked.

The list of archives collected over the subsequent four decades are eloquent testimony to the success of the Archive. Successive issues of the Newsletter, which itself has evolved from its first simple issue in 1984/5 into a very attractive annual publication, demonstrate the range, depth and quality of the material which has been collected and preserved, from the records of the main political parties in Wales and their constituency branches to personal archives of a very large number of Welsh MPs and notable public figures, something one suspects which might not have happened otherwise.

From early on, the Archive staff have been strongly supported by enthusiastic members of the representative Advisory Committee, established by the Library's Board of Trustees, and drawn from across the political spectrum and including politicians, academics and journalists sitting side-by-side with Library staff. The first meeting of the Committee was held in April 1984 and the members proved to be an invaluable source of advice, often enthusiastically bringing collections of material to meetings, directing the staff of the Archive to material of interest, or making representations to constituencies and local parties on behalf of the Library. And it was at the Committee that the idea of an Annual Lecture was proposed which, from 1987 has been a key focus of the Archive, enabling distinguished politicians and academics to reflect on their careers in a public setting.

It is also a source of great pleasure that staff of the Archive over the years have themselves contributed greatly to our understanding of Welsh politics. Beti Jones' publications include an invaluable handbook of Welsh electoral statistics while John Graham Jones has published innumerable articles on Welsh political history. Gwyn Jenkins is, of course, a notable author of Welsh history and biography, while the very first research assistant at the Archive, Paul O'Leary, eventually became the Sir John Williams Professor of Welsh History at Aberystwyth University and gave the Archive's annual lecture in 2021.

Over the last few years new challenges have appeared, of course, not least the advent of social media and the gradual disappearance of the older forms of record-keeping, hand-written correspondence, or the traditional letter. Yet, as always, the Library and the Archive are alive to this and are seeking to respond accordingly.

And I am particularly glad that, forty years on, the Archive continues to thrive under the guidance of Rob Philips and that some of us, still members of the Advisory Committee after forty years, can reflect on a vision achieved.

Sir Deian Hopkin is former President of the National Library of Wales and Vice Chancellor of London South Bank University. He is President of The Honourable Society of Cymrodonion and holds a PhD in History from Aberystwyth University. He has been involved with the Welsh Political Archive since its inception.

Dadgoloneiddio yn yr Archifau

Mae'n hen bryd gwneud gwaith dadgoloneiddio mewn archifau. Ac efallai ei bod hi'n hen bryd ei wneud ond mae'r gwaith o ddiffinio safbwyt y Llyfrgell ar gynwysoldeb ac amrywiaeth yn amserol. Yn ystod y blynnyddoedd diwethaf mae'r byd wedi dysgu gwerthfawrogi amrywiaeth fel arf hanfodol ar gyfer twf a ffyniant yn y gymdeithas.

Mae'r Ymerodraeth Brydeinig yn un a oedd yn ymestyn ar draws gwahanol genhedloedd ac a barhaodd am flynyddoedd lawer. Mae dadgoloneiddio mewn archifau yn ymwnaed â dod o hyd i fylchau yn ein casgliad, ymdrin â thermau amhriodol a ddefnyddiwyd yn flaenorol wrth catalogio, annog defnyddio adnoddau archifol a phartneru â chymunedau amrywiol sydd wedi'u tangynrychioli.

Fel pob prosiect, mae ymchwil, trafodaeth a myfyrio dwfn yn rhan greiddiol ohono. Mae'n broses raddol sy'n gofyn am amynedd ac ymroddiad. Ers dechrau fy'r ôl rwyf wedi cychwyn ar nifer o brosiectau gan gynnwys creu Calendr Amrywiaeth, arddangosfa ar gyfer Mis Hanes Pobl Dduon ym mis Hydref a chydweithio â chymunedau sydd wedi'u tangynrychioli yng Nghymru.

Mae'r Calendr Amrywiaeth yn adnodd a gynhelir ar wefan y Llyfrgell. Mae'n cynnwys cyfuniad o wyliau crefyddol yn ogystal â digwyddiadau sy'n ymwnaed â diwylliant, cydraddoldeb, amrywiaeth a chynhwysiant a dyddiadau allwedol, ynghyd â dolenni i eitemau perthnasol yng nghasgliadau'r Llyfrgell. Bydd yn adnodd i dynnu sylw staff y Llyfrgell a darllenwyr at ddeunydd ac i gefnogi allgymorth addysgol. Unwaith y caiff y calendr ei lansio byddwn yn gwerthuso'r adborth ac yn nodi ac yn llenwi unrhyw fylchau.

Fy mhrif nod yw sicrhau bod y prosiectau rwy'n ymgymryd â nhw fel rhan o fy'r ôl yn cael eu teilwra'n benodol i Gymru a Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru a'u bod yn cael effaith ac yn gynaliadwy.

Miidong Daloeng yw'r Swyddog Dadgoloneiddio Archifau a dechreuodd weithio ar brosiect 2 flynedd yn y Llyfrgell ym mis Ionawr 2023. Decolonisation in the Archives

Decolonisation in archives is long overdue. Overdue the work may be but the work to define the Library's stand on inclusivity and diversity is timely. In recent years the world has gained appreciation for diversity as an essential tool for the growth and prosperity in society.

The British Empire is one that spanned across various nations and lasted for many years. Its legacy is still clear in many institutions of learning, research and heritage including the National Library of Wales. Thus, when the term decolonisation is mentioned, archivists are often confronted with questions such as "where do we begin?", "what should we do?" and "how do we do it?". Decolonisation in archives is concerned with finding the gaps in our collection, addressing inappropriate terms that have been previously used in cataloguing, encouraging the use of archive resources and partnering with various communities who have been under-represented.

Like every project, this is one of research, discussion and deep reflection. It is a gradual process that requires patience and dedication. Since the commencement of my role I have embarked on several projects including creating a Diversity Calendar, an exhibition for Black History Month in October and collaboration with under-represented communities in Wales.

The Diversity Calendar is a resource hosted on the Library's website. It includes a combination of religious festivals as well as cultural, equality, diversity and inclusion related events and key dates, along with links to relevant items in the Library's collections. It will serve as a resource to signpost material for Library staff, readers and to support educational outreach. Once the calendar is launched we will evaluate feedback and identify and fill any gaps.

My main aim is to ensure that the projects I undertake as part of my role are specifically tailored to Wales and the National Library of Wales and are both impactful and sustainable.

Miidong Daloeng is the Archives Decolonisation Officer and began work on a 2 year project at the Library in January 2023. She has a postgraduate degree in Digital Information and Media Management (Archives) from Aberystwyth University and has had over five years' experience working in institutes of learning, research and finance.

Ddydd iau 16 Mawrth 2023 bu'r Llyfrgell yn dathlu agoriad Canolfan Archif Ddarlledu Cymru, sydd wedi sicrhau bod hanner miliwn o glipiau o hanes teledu a radio Cymru ar gael i'r cyhoedd. Dyma'r archif ddarlledu genedlaethol gyntaf yn y Deyrnas Unedig, ac mae'n un o'r archifau darlledu rhwyddaf i'w defnyddio yn Ewrop, ac sy'n trawsnewid mynediad cyhoeddus i ganrif o hanes darlledu Cymru gyda ffilm, fideo a sain yn y Gymraeg a'r Saesneg wedi'u digidog yn barod i'w darganfod.

Gall ymwelwyr chwilio am recordiadau sain o radio'r BBC yng Nghymru o'r 1930au ymlaen, darllediadau teledu gan y BBC a darlledwyr masnachol yng Nghymru gan gynnwys HTV Cymru ac ITV Cymru Wales o'r 1950au ymlaen ac o 1982, holl raglenni S4C, y sianel deledu Gymraeg gyntaf. Mae'r rhain yn cynnwys adegau hynod arwyddocaol yn hanes Cymru fel boddi Tryweryn, trychineb Aber-fan, streiciau'r Glowyr ac agor y Senedd. Cynhwysir hefyd glipiau sy'n ymdrin â phob agwedd ar fywyd Cymru, o ddarlleidiadau helaeth o chwaraeon Cymru ers yr 1940au i adloniant a drama gan gynnwys opera sebon hiraf y BBC – *Pobol y Cwm* – a ddarllewdwyd gyntaf yn 1974. Bydd y gwasanaeth allweddol yn cael ei ddarparu drwy derfynellau a fydd yn rhoi mynediad digynsail i'r cyhoedd ac academyddion i ymchwilio i gasgliad helaeth o ddeunydd digidol o dreftadaeth glyweledol Cymru.

Mae Canolfan Archif Ddarlledu Cymru hefyd yn cynnig arddangosfa ryngweithiol, gan ddefnyddio'r dechnoleg ddiweddaraf, a fydd yn newid yn rheolaidd. Mae hyn yn cynnwys lolfa sain a fideo sy'n gweithredu fel silffoedd llyfrau clyweledol ar gyfer pori achlysuol.

Wales Broadcast Archive

On Thursday 16 March 2023 the Library celebrated the opening of the Wales Broadcast Archive Centre, with half a million clips from the history of Welsh television and radio available to the public. It is the first national broadcast archive in the United Kingdom, and one of the most usable broadcast archives in Europe, transforming public access to a century of Welsh broadcast history with film, video and audio in both Welsh and English digitised for discovery.

Visitors can search sound recordings of BBC radio in Wales from the 1930s onwards, television broadcasts by the BBC and commercial broadcasters in Wales including HTV Wales and ITV Cymru Wales from the 1950s onwards and from 1982, all the programmes of S4C, the first Welsh language TV channel. These include hugely significant moments in Welsh history such as the drowning of Tryweryn, the Aber-fan disaster, the Miners' strikes and the opening of the Senedd. Also included are clips that cover all aspects of Welsh life, from extensive coverage of Welsh sport since the 1940s to entertainment and drama including the BBC's longest running soap opera – *Pobol y Cwm* – which first aired in 1974. The key service will be delivered through terminals which will enable unprecedented access for the public and academics to research a vast collection of digitised material from Wales' audio-visual heritage.

The Wales Broadcast Archive Centre also offers an interactive exhibition, using cutting edge technology, that will change regularly. This includes an audio and video lounge that function as audio-visual bookshelves for casual browsing.

While the Wales Broadcast Archive will be housed at The National Library of Wales in Aberystwyth, there will be 13 'Clip Corners' across Wales providing local access to the content located at:
