Sefydlwyd yr Archif Wleidyddol Gymreig yn 1983 i gydlynú'r gwaith o gasglu tystiolaeth ddogfennol o bob math am wleidyddiaeth Cymru. Cesglir cofnodion a phapurau pleidiau gwleidyddol, gwleidyddion, mudiadau lled-wleidyddol, ymgyrchoedd a charfanau pwys; taflenni, pamffledi ac effemera printiedig eraill; posteri a ffotograffau; gwefannau a thapiau o raglenni radio a theledu. Ni chyfyngir ei gweithgareddau i un adran o fewn y Llyfrgell.

Yn unol â Pholisi Datblygu Casgliadau Llyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru, mae'r Archif Wleidyddol Gymreig yn casglu papurau personol gwleidyddion sydd wedi chwarae rhan bwysig ym mywyd y genedl ac unigolion sydd â phroffil uchel oherwydd eu gwaith ymgyrchu ar faterion cenedlaethol neu ryngwladol.

Rydym yn casglu:

- papurau Aelodau Senedd y DU, Aelodau Senedd Cymru, Aelodau Senedd Ewrop ac Arglwyddi os ydynt, er enghraift, wedi gwasanaethu fel Ysgrifennydd Gwladol, arweinydd plaid wleidyddol, gweinidog, cadeirydd pwylgor blaenllaw; nid ydym fel arfer yn casglu papurau etholaethol na phapurau aelodau etholedig eraill
- archifau cenedlaethol pleidiau gwleidyddol
- archifau carfanau pwys o cenedlaethol, a grwpiau sy'n ymgyrchu ar faterion gwleidyddol o bwys cenedlaethol
- effemera etholiadol o bob etholaeth yng Nghymru ar gyfer etholiadau a refferenda cenedlaethol.

THE WELSH POLITICAL ARCHIVE

The Welsh Political Archive was set up in 1983 to co-ordinate the collection of documentary evidence of all kinds about politics in Wales. It collects the records and papers of political parties, politicians, quasi-political organisations, campaigns and pressure groups; leaflets, pamphlets and other printed ephemera; posters and photographs; websites and tapes of radio and television programmes. Its work is not restricted to a specific department within the Library.

In accordance with the National Library of Wales' Collection Development Policy, the Welsh Political Archive collects the personal papers of politicians who have played an important role in the life of the nation and individuals with a high profile for campaigning on national or international issues.

We collect:

- the papers of Members of the UK Parliament, Members of the Senedd, Members of the European Parliament and Lords if they have for example held positions such as Secretary of State, party leader, minister, senior committee chair; we do not usually collect the papers of other elected members or constituency papers
- the national archives of political parties
- archives of national pressure groups and groups which campaign on national issues
- election ephemera from all constituencies in Wales for national elections and referenda.



Re: Political reaction to reports from Baghdad

The War Cabinet discussed broadcast reports from Iraq this morning. According to Mike Brunsden, concerned that the broadcasters weren't getting the full story on some items, but it is not the Government's view not have correspondents in Baghdad. They acknowledge it is a difficult job to do.

In the Commons only two MPs raised it during Business. Christopher Soames (again) and Dudley Smith. They expressed sympathy with the views expressed by Soames. Representations had been made to the broadcasting authorities.

Privately later he was apparently indicating that representations may be made to the broadcasters. That other Conservative MPs are also concerned on the particular, Jeremy Bowen's reporting yesterday and to be unbalanced.

My view is that this is still low level on the political scale.







I am writing to you now to give you some additional material which may be of value in the debate. You may remember that Sir John Hope mentioned something which he called the Commonwealth Development Finance Corporation (at least that was the way it was reported by Reuter). So far as we can discover no such body exists. There is however a semi-commercial concern, the Commonwealth Development Finance Company Limited which does do useful work on the purely commercial side. A minority of its shares are held by the Bank of England and its objects are, according to the information we received from the Colonial Office some three years ago, to increase Commonwealth resources and strengthen the Sterling Area's balance of payments and to assist its participants and contacts in providing ready access to British industrial finance. This is quite all right so far as it goes but the help which it can give is extremely limited. A representative came to the Gold Coast and I did have some discussions with him but the only practical matter in which we are now concerned is that the Company have been asked whether they would join us in financing a provincial match factory. The total authorised capital is only £155,000 and of this the commercial profit of between 7 to 10% of course for me to allow this. I give it to you.

THE 2023 ANNUAL LECTURE

The 2023 annual lecture was given by distinguished academic, political commentator and former Welsh international footballer, Prof. Laura McAllister on 22 November 2023 at the JOMEC lecture theatre in Cardiff. This was only the second time that the lecture has been held outside Aberystwyth. In the lecture, entitled *Reason not rancour: a route to a better Wales*, Laura looked into why Wales is a nation so rich in talent, imagination and passion, but painfully poor when measured against many basic metrics and examined both the good and bad during the last 25 years.

Drawing on her experience at UEFA, as an academic, chair of the Expert panel on Assembly Electoral Reform and co-chair of the Independent Commission on the Constitutional Future of Wales, Laura considered what Wales does well, what Wales does badly and practical steps to use our talent to bring about radical improvement.

One of the key issues was the collapse in trust between the people and their leaders. Laura concluded that we need to resurrect and recast the idea of public service and public duty and diversify our leaders. We need to dispel the myth of the charismatic, authoritative leader who will make things happen, and stand up ourselves. We need to be less risk averse, but we need to accept that aiming higher will mean that we often fail to get there. We need to win people over and shake off the self-doubt; radical changes such as creating a million Welsh speakers or dealing with the climate emergency will only happen if we make revolutionary changes and people believe that we can do it.

OTHER EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

The Welsh Political Archive contributed a number of items from the collections to a small exhibition in the Senedd between 4 May and July 18 to mark 25 years since the first elections to the then National Assembly for Wales.

The Library welcomed a delegation from the Embassy of Cuba as part of their itinerary during a visit to Aberystwyth on 8 March 2024.

Phil Colley, great-nephew of journalist Gareth Jones, whose archive is held at the National Library of Wales, gave a lecture entitled *The Life and Afterlife of a Welsh Hero* in the Library on 22 May 2024. A small exhibition of photographs from Gareth's archive were displayed in the Summers Room before the lecture.

Rhys Davies took some items from the collection to the Houses of Parliament in London on 26 February to support the celebration of the founding of the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society 120 years ago.

The Welsh Political Archive has contributed to a new collection of Trade Union websites. The collection is held by the British Library and curated by members of the Society for the Study of Labour History Archives and Resources Committee.

Miidong Daloeng, the Archives Decolonisation Project officer, gave two talks on the importance of diversity with detailed insights on the Library

decolonisation project, first at the Aberystwyth University event entitled 'Screening and Sharing: Decolonial Pedagogies in Wales Higher Education,' and the other at the CILIP Cymru annual conference where she shared her experience and the importance of the project with tips and measures that could be considered when embarking on a similar project.

Rob Phillips visited Bangor University on 10 March 2024 to speak to undergraduate and postgraduate students on the Welsh Political Archive and sources available to them for their research.

Miidong Daloeng curated an exhibition entitled *Asia Through The Lens* which ran from 1 June until the beginning of September 2024. It stems from the Wales Anti-Racist Action Plan that promotes and celebrates the diversity of Wales and gives a new perspective on the resources in the National Library's collections.

A conference on the life of the communist and anti-racial segregation campaigner David Iyon Jones was held in Aberystwyth on 28–29 June. Highlights included showing the documentary by Gwyn Alf Williams, *The African from Aberystwyth* at the National Library of Wales with director Colin Thomas speaking on filming in Apartheid-era South Africa alongside a screening of *London Recruits* at the Aberystwyth Arts Centre and the launch of *A Voice for Freedom Vol. 1: David Iyon Jones in Wales and South Africa* at Canolfan Arad Goch, Aberystwyth.




1923 WELSH WOMEN'S PEACE PETITION

A year following the return of the chest to its home in Wales, containing the signatures of nearly 400,000 Welsh women campaigning for peace, the efforts to catalogue and digitise the 1923 Welsh Women's Peace Petition collection have since been completed. Although my role in archiving the collection concluded in March 2024, I am still actively involved in the next steps of the project. Namely in how the collection will be made more easily accessible to the wider public.

While the Petition's contents are fully accessible digitally and available to request through our cataloguing system, AtoM, the process for finding specific signatures continues to be time-consuming. Since the beginning of the year, the monumental task of transcribing all the names and addresses on the petition documents via a crowdsourcing project has commenced. The data provided will be presented via the Library's website later this year and continuously added to as more of the collection is transcribed. Users will have the ability to search signatures by name, address (including street address, community ward and county) or via an interactive map, which will show users the number of signatures provided from each county.

Search results will be displayed to users through a snippet of the original document with the transcribed entry above in addition to information on the box and petition the signature has been provided from, should users ever want to consult the original document.

Once released, the website will act as a useful tool for users who wish to further their family history research beyond the 1921 census. Additionally, this may be the first time many have ever seen their relative's signature on a document. I've had the pleasure of personally helping people (both users and staff) find their family on the petition and their heartwarming reactions have always reaffirmed the importance of enabling access to such a collection and constantly inspired me during the cataloguing process. This website will enable many others to have a similar experience.

I feel incredibly grateful to have had the opportunity to have been a part of this project. The Peace Petition was the first chance I had to catalogue an archival collection following my studies at university and it's been an exciting experience. Not only in playing a part in uncovering the hidden history of this campaign for peace but also in engaging with people on the importance of this collection for the history of women, Wales and peace movements in the interwar period.

Oscar Seager is the archivist who was responsible for cataloguing and preparing the Welsh Women's Peace Petition for digitisation and has given numerous talks and written articles to promote the project. He is currently a Senior Service Assistant at the National Library of Wales.

Y tri arall y mae eu papurau ar gael yn y Llyfrgell yw Ron Davies (1997–1998), Paul Murphy (1999–2002 a 2008–2009) a Peter Hain (2002–2008 a 2009–2010).

Yr ychwanegiad diweddaraf i'r grŵp hwn yw mwy o papurau yr Arglwydd Thomas o Wydir a roddwyd i'r Archif ym mis Medi 2023. Mae'r papurau hyn wedi'u catalogio yn ystod y flwyddyn ddiwethaf. Maent yn cynnwys tri ffotoograff a dynnyd yn ôl pob tebyg yn Nhŷ Gwydyr o'r pum Ysgrifennydd Cymreig cyntaf, a dynnyd rywbryd rhwng penodi John Morris yn Ysgrifennydd Gwladol ar 5 Mawrth 1974 a marwolaeth Jim Griffiths ar 7 Awst 1975. Mae'r llun hwn yn fwy anffurfiol ei natur o'i gymharu â'r portread grŵp mwy ffurfiol arall sy'n portreadu'r pump cyntaf i ddal y swydd a grëwyd 60 mlynedd yn ôl.



60 YEARS OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR WALES

The post of Secretary of State for Wales came into existence on 17 October 1964 and The Welsh Political Archive currently holds papers of nine former secretaries, including the first six incumbents: James Griffiths (1964–1966), Cledwyn Hughes (1966–1968), George Thomas (1968–1970), Peter Thomas (1970–1974), John Morris (1974–1979) and Nicholas Edwards (1979–1987). The other three post-holders with their papers housed at the Library are Ron Davies (1997–1998), Paul Murphy (1999–2002 and 2008–2009) and Peter Hain (2002–2008 and 2009–2010).

The most recent addition to this group was a donation of further papers of Lord Thomas of Gwydir made in September 2023, and which has been catalogued during the past year. It includes three photographs presumably taken at Gwydyr House of the first five Welsh Secretaries, taken sometime between the appointment of John Morris as Secretary of State on 5 March 1974 and the death of Jim Griffiths on 7 August 1975. This photograph portrays an informal setting in comparison to the other more formal group portrait that documents the first five to hold the office that was created 60 years ago.

Yn fwy diweddar, mae eitemau o wahanol gymunedau sydd heb gynrychiolaeth ddigonol wedi'u cynnwys a gweithiau celf wedi'u comisiynu i sicrhau mwy o amrywiaeth, ac i ddadgoloneiddio ein casgliadau ymhellach.

Fel rhan o ymdrechion dadgoloneiddio'r Llyfrgell, curadwyd dwy arddangosfa: **Myfyddod - Arddangosfa Mis Hanes Pobl Ddu a Golwg ar Asia** yn fwyaf diweddar. Curadwyd yr arddangosfeydd hyn i wella gweledded ein casgliadau amrywiol, annog ymchwil, a rhannu straeon a allai fod heb eu clywed o'r blaen. OUR JOURNEY TOWARDS AN ANTI-RACIST WALES

For centuries, archives were established and governed by wealthy families or official record-keeping bodies. As a result, most archival collections primarily focused on their owners, who were predominantly male, white, affluent, or middle-class. This has led to an underrepresentation of the diverse population of Wales.



However, with the expansion of the British Empire, growth and development of journalism, travel, friendship, campaigns and activism, collections representing diverse cultures and peoples have become an integral part of our archives. This is exemplified by collections such as the Peter Hain Papers, Gareth Vaughan Jones Papers, the Wales Anti-Apartheid Movement Archive, Ena Niedergang (Wales-China) Papers, Sir Davies Leonard Triston's bundles of manuscripts in Farsi, Sanskrit, and Arabic, Robert Clive Collection, Benjamin Millingchamp Collection, and various manuscripts from around the world. More recently, items from various underrepresented communities have been included and artworks commissioned to further diversify and decolonise our collections.

As part of the Library's decolonisation efforts, two exhibitions have been curated: **Reflection - Black History Month Exhibition** and the most recent **Asia Through Lenses**. These exhibitions were curated to enhance the visibility of our diverse collections, encourage research, and share stories that may have previously gone unheard. Most, these exhibitions were designed to connect people and spark impactful conversations on race, empire, and identity as we strive towards a Wales free of racism by 2030.

Miidong Daloeng is the Archives Decolonisation Officer and began work on a 2 year project at the Library in January 2023. She has a postgraduate degree in Digital Information and Media Management (Archives) from Aberystwyth University and has over five years' experience working in institutes of learning, research and finance.

SUT MAE DEDDF SENEDD YN DOD YN GYFRAITH?

Y cam olaf yn y broses o greu cyfraith newydd yn Neddau Senedd San Steffan yw arwyddo cydsyniad y brenin yn Senedd y Deyrnas Unedig.

Yn y canol oesoedd arwyddai brenhinoedd eu caniatâd yn bersonol ond cafodd Deddf Atentiad y Frenhines Katherine Howard, a oedd yn rhifo troseddau honedig cyn-wraig y Brenin erbyn hynny, gydsyniad gan y Comisiynwyr Brenhinol, gan y barnwyd ei bod yn rhy boenus i'r Brenin gydsynio ei hun.

Dros y canrifedd daeth arwyddo cydsyniad gan y Comisiynwyr Brenhinol ar ran y Brenin yn ddull arferol o arwyddo cydsyniad a'r frenhines olaf i gydsynio i Fesur San Steffan yn bersonol oedd y Frenhines Fictoria yn 1854.

Cafodd y weithdrefn ar gyfer rhoi Cydsyniad Brenhinol drwy Gomisiwn ei symleiddio gan Ddeddf Cydsyniad Brenhinol 1967. Mae'r weithdrefn amgen hon yn golygu bod y brenin/brenhines yn llofnodi Breinlythyrau; datganiadau neu gyfarwyddiadau cyhoeddus ac agored gan y brenin/brenhines - wedi hynny bydd Senedd y Deyrnas Unedig yn cael ei hysbysu am Gydsyniad Brenhinol a datganiad byr yn cael ei wneud i Dŷ'r Cyffredin gan y Llefarydd, ac yn Nhŷ'r Arglwyddi gan yr Arglwydd Lefarydd. Bellach, dim ond pan fydd Senedd y Deyrnas Unedig yn cael ei haddoedi, cyn etholiad cyffredinol, y mae arwyddo Cydsyniad Brenhinol gan y Comisiwn, ynghyd â'r seremoniau cysylltiedig, yn digwydd.

Y weithdrefn symlach o dan Ddeddf 1967 yw'r model ar gyfer dynodi Cydsyniad Brenhinol i Ddeddfau Senedd Cymru. Unwaith y bydd Bil wedi cwblhau ei holl gamau gerbron y Senedd, mae'n barod i'w gyflwyno ar gyfer Cydsyniad Brenhinol, ar yr amod:

- nad yw wedi'i gyfeirio at y Goruchaf Lys gan naill ai Gwnsler Cyffredinol Cymru neu Dwrnai Cyffredinol Cymru a Lloegr ar y sail ei fod yn codi cwestiynau am gymhwysedd deddfwriaethol y Senedd, neu fod ei ddarpariaethau'n ymwneud â phwnc na all y Senedd ei ddiwygio; neu
- nad yw'r Ysgrifennydd Gwladol wedi gwneud gorchymyn yn atal y Bil rhag cael ei gyflwyno ar gyfer Cydsyniad Brenhinol ar y sail y byddai'n effeithio'n andwyol ar weithrediad y gyfraith fel y mae'n gymwys yn Lloegr neu y byddai'n anghydraws â rhwymedigaethau rhyngwladol neu fuddiannau amddiffyn neu ddiogelwch cenedlaethol. Hyd yn hyn, ni ddefnyddiwyd y pŵer hwn erioed.

HOW DOES AN ACT OF THE SENEDD BECOME LAW?

The signifying of the monarch's consent to Acts of the Westminster Parliament is the final stage in the creation of new law by the King in Parliament.

In mediaeval times monarchs signified their consent in person but the Act Of Attainer of Queen Katherine Howard, which enumerated the alleged crimes of his by then ex-wife, was given consent by Royal Commissioners as it was deemed too painful for the King to assent in person.

Over the centuries the signifying of consent by Royal Commissioners on behalf of the King became the normal method of signifying assent and the last monarch to give assent to a Westminster Bill in person was Queen Victoria in 1854.

The procedure to give Royal Assent by Commissions was simplified by the Royal Assent Act 1967. This alternative procedure involves the monarch signing Letters Patent; public and open declarations or instructions by the monarch - following which Royal Assent is notified to Parliament and a brief statement is made to the House of Commons by the Speaker, and in the House of Lords by the Lord Speaker. The signifying of Royal Assent by Commission, with the accompanying ceremonials, now generally only takes place when Parliament is prorogued, prior to a general election.

The simplified procedure under the 1967 Act is the model for signifying Royal Assent to Acts of the Senedd. Once a Bill has completed all its stages before the Senedd, it is ready to be presented for Royal Assent, provided:

- it has not been referred to the Supreme Court by either the Counsel General for Wales or the Attorney-General for England and Wales on the grounds that it raises questions about the legislative competence of the Senedd, or its provisions relate to subject matter that the Senedd cannot amend; or
- or that the Secretary of State has not made an order preventing the Bill being submitted for Royal Assent on the grounds that it would adversely affect the operation of the law as it applies in England or would be incompatible with international obligations or the interests of defence or national security.
To date, this power has never been used.

Once a Bill can be submitted for Royal Assent the duty of doing so falls to the Llywydd (the Presiding Officer of the Senedd). This is done by sending Letters Patent, prepared for the Llywydd by the Welsh Government, to the Royal Household.

The Letters are in formal language and are 'signed with His Majesty's own hand signifying His Assent'. They are addressed to the Keeper of the Welsh Seal (which is a separate office held by the First Minister of Wales) who is instructed to affix the Welsh Seal to the Letters. The signed Letters are then returned to the Welsh Government and the seal is affixed by the Keeper of the Welsh Seal by making an impression of the seal on the Letters, and the signing of the Letters by the King is also completed.





Bydd y sêl hon yn cael ei disodli maes o law gyda sêl newydd yn dwyn delw'r Brenin.

Unwaith y bydd y Breinlythyrau wedi'u selio, cânt eu gwneud yn hysbys gan Geidwad y Sêl Gymreig i Glenc y Senedd. Ar y pwynt hwn y daw'r Ddeddf yn gyfraith.

Y Ddeddf gyntaf i gael Cydsyniad Brenhinol oedd Ddeddf Cynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru (leithoedd Swyddogol) 2012 (2012 dc 1).

Ar ôl cael ei hysbysu am y Breinlythyrau, mae Clerc y Senedd yn arysgrifio manylion y Cydsyniad Brenhinol a rhif y Ddeddf at ddibenion dyfynnu ar gopi printiedig a rhwymedig o'r Ddeddf. Daw'r manylion hyn yn rhan o'r Ddeddf a daw'r fersiwn hon yn 'brint swyddogol' o'r Ddeddf. Mae'r Clerc hefyd yn gwneud ac yn ardystio copi o'r print swyddogol, a anfonir at Argraffydd y Brenin ac a fydd yn ymddangos mewn fersiynau cyhoedddeg o'r Ddeddf, er enghraift ar [Legislation.gov.uk](https://legislation.gov.uk). Y camau olaf yn y weithdrefn yw gosod hysbysiadau cyhoeddus o'r Cydsyniad Brenhinol yng nghyhoeddiadau *The Gazette* Llundain, Caeredin a Belfast.

Yna rhaid i'r Clerc anfon y print swyddogol at Lyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru, sef ystofra barhaol swyddogol deddfwriaeth y Senedd. Anfonir y Breinlythyrau hefyd i'r Lyfrgell Genedlaethol gan swyddogion y Senedd ar ran Ceidwad y Sêl Gymreig.



Wrth gyrraedd y Llyfrgell Genedlaethol ychwanegir y printiau swyddogol at y catalog ar-lein. Rhoddir y printiau unigol mewn ffolderi archifol, eu labelu a'u rhoi mewn blychau archifol cyn eu trosglwyddo i'w storio'n barhaol mewn celloedd sy'n cydymffurfio â BS 4971 ar gyfer storio deunyddiau archifol. Yna gall aelodau'r cyhoedd gael mynediad i'r printiau swyddogol yn ystafell ddarllen y Llyfrgell drwy wneud cais drwy'r catalog.

Between 2006 and 2011 when the then National Assembly had limited powers to pass primary legislation, known as Measures, 'Royal Approval' was signified at a meeting of the Privy Council. However, when the National Assembly was empowered to pass its own Acts, a Welsh Seal became necessary. Unlike the English and Scottish seals, which historically were double sided and suspended by ribbon from the document, the Welsh Seal is single sided and designed for use with a red paper wafer in accordance with modern practice. The Welsh Seal, designed and made by the Royal Mint in Llantrisant, has three elements: an effigy of Queen Elizabeth II, the Royal Badge of Wales (approved in 2008 and used on Senedd legislation) and 'Y Ddraig Goch'. This seal will be replaced in due course with a new seal bearing the effigy of the King.

Once the Letters Patent have been sealed they are notified by the Keeper of the Welsh Seal to the Clerk of the Senedd. It is at this point that the Act becomes law.

The first Act to receive Royal Assent was the National Assembly for Wales (Official Languages) Act 2012 (2012 anaw 1).

The Clerk of the Senedd on receiving notification of the Letters Patent, inscribes the details of Royal Assent and the number of the Act for citation purposes on a printed and bound copy of the Act. These details become part of the Act and this version then becomes the 'official print' of the Act. The Clerk also makes and certifies a copy of the official print, which is sent to the King's Printer and will appear in published versions of the Act, for example on [Legislation.gov.uk](https://legislation.gov.uk). The final steps in the procedure are the placing of public notices of Royal Assent in the London, Edinburgh and Belfast *Gazettes*.

The official print must then be sent by the Clerk to the National Library of Wales, which is the official permanent repository of Senedd legislation. The Letters Patent are also sent to the National Library by Senedd officials on behalf of the Keeper of the Welsh Seal.

On arrival at the National Library the official prints are added to the online catalogue. The individual prints are placed into archival folders, labelled and put into archival boxes before being transferred for permanent storage in cells which conform to BS 4971 for storage of archival materials. The official prints can then be accessed by members of the public in the Library's reading room by making a request through the catalogue.
